- 1. Sanctioned capacity of students
- 2. Names of Students admitted, so that the Students who are admitted beyond the sanctioned strength would be aware that their admission would be illegal.

Therefore, all the Principals of Government/Private Nursing Colleges in the State are hereby instructed that they should not admit more number of students, beyond the sanctioned/permissible limit. Any deviation of above instructions would be viewed very seriously and necessary action will be initiated against those institutions.
